- Ensure safe drinking water in our schools.
- Expand insurance coverage for 3-D mammograms and breast cancer screening.
- Expand equitable access to maternal postpartum care. •
- Create higher education opportunities for students with developmental disabilities.
- Prevent bullying of elderly, disabled residents and veterans in public housing.
- Establish a model school policy on suicide prevention.
- Create a women's rights history trail.
- Establish a program to address maternal mental health conditions and substance use disorders of pregnant and postpartum individuals.
- Expand access to adoption.

These are just a few of the issues I have been working on to improve lives across our district.
